## CONSIDERATIONS:

- AFRICAN SWINE FEVER (ASF) IS A VIRAL DISEASE THAT AFFECTS ONLY PIGS.
- PEOPLE CANNOT BECOME SICK FROM THIS VIRUS, SO IT IS SAFE FOR CARETAKERS TO INTERACT WITH THE PIGS AND THE MEAT IS SAFE TO EAT.
- DOMESTIC DISEASES SUCH AS PRRS OR SALMONELLA CAN PRODUCE SIMILAR CLINICAL SIGNS.




