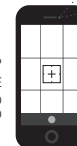


SHOWER IN/OUT

1. OPEN CAMERA APP
2. FOCUS ON QR CODE
3. TAP BANNER TO WATCH VIDEO



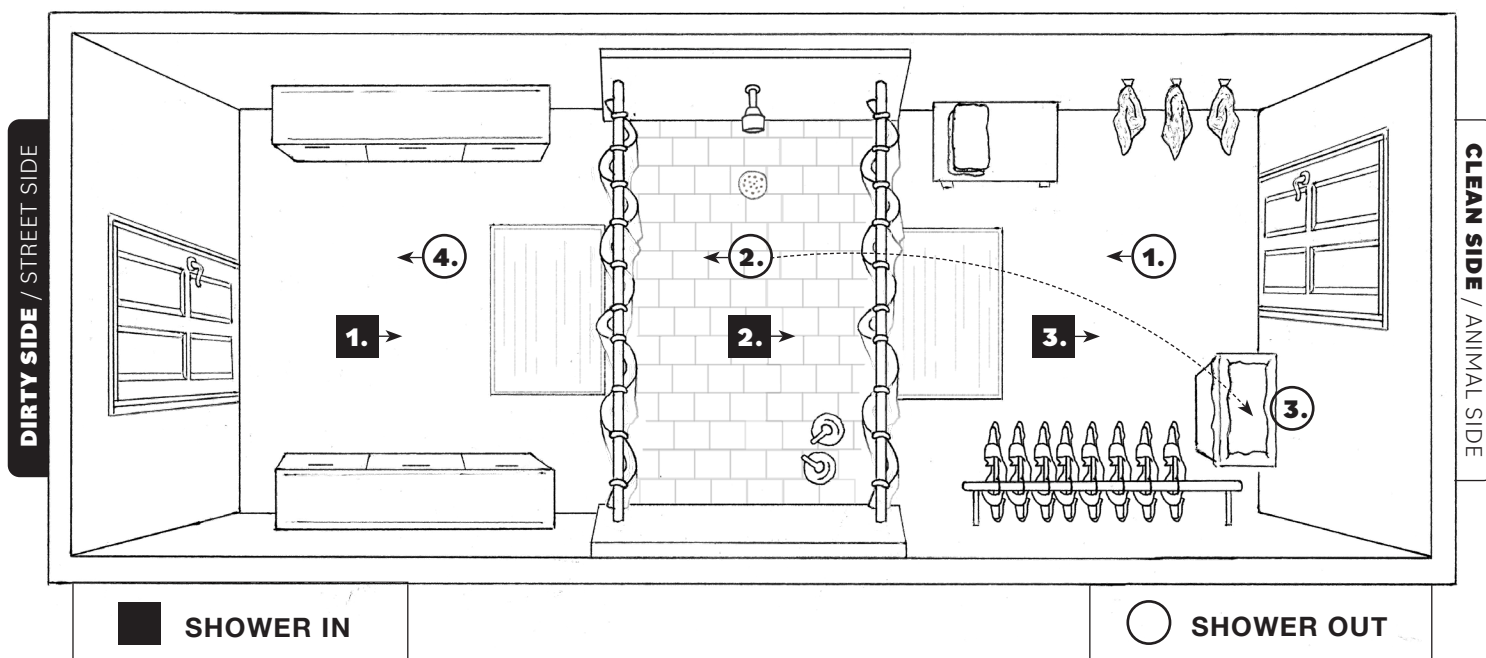
CONSIDERATIONS:

- LEAVE PERSONAL ITEMS SUCH AS JEWELRY ON DIRTY SIDE. ASK FARM STAFF IF NEED CLARIFICATION. GLASSES CAN BE WASHED THROUGH.
- FOLLOW ALL SITE-SPECIFIC BIOSECURITY REQUIREMENTS.
- CHECK WITH THE FARM TO SEE IF UNDERGARMENTS AND APPROPRIATE SIZED CLOTHING WILL BE AVAILABLE.
- KNOCK BEFORE ENTERING THE SHOWER ROOM TO ENSURE IT IS NOT OCCUPIED.

SHOWER IN INSTRUCTIONS:

STEP 1.

ENTER THE SHOWER ROOM ON THE DIRTY SIDE AND BEGIN BY REMOVING ALL OF YOUR CLOTHING.

STEP 2.

TAKE A FULL SHOWER USING SOAP, FOCUSING ON YOUR HANDS, ARMS, FACE, AND HAIR.

STEP 3.

WHEN FINISHED, STEP ONTO THE CLEAN SIDE OF THE SHOWER ROOM, WHERE THERE WILL BE TOWELS AND CLEAN BARN CLOTHES TO PUT ON.

SHOWER OUT INSTRUCTIONS:

STEP 1.

ONCE FINISHED ON THE FARM, STEP INTO THE CLEAN SIDE OF THE SHOWER ROOM AND REMOVE ALL OF YOUR FARM CLOTHES.

STEP 2.

TAKE A FULL SHOWER USING SOAP, FOCUSING ON YOUR HANDS, ARMS, FACE, AND HAIR.

STEP 3.

ONCE FINISHED, DRY OFF WITH A CLEAN TOWEL AND TOSS IT BACK ONTO THE CLEAN SIDE BEFORE STEPPING ONTO THE DIRTY SIDE.

STEP 4.

DRESS AND EXIT THE FARM.
